The Education Foundation of Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) is proud to announce the Teach for Anne Arundel Scholarship (T4AA), a four-year scholarship program intended for graduating high school seniors from AACPS who will be enrolled in a college program that prepares them for teaching certification upon graduation.

Requirements

Note - Only ONE application will be considered per student.

- Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) or Anne Arundel County Public Charter Schools Graduating Seniors who intend to pursue a college degree, obtain a Maryland teaching certification, and return to AACPS to teach
- Must have had an excellent attendance record in high school and have at least a 2.5 GPA (unweighted)
- Teach for Anne Arundel (T4AA) applicants must be accepted to a degree granting college or university in Maryland where education courses are offered, including Anne Arundel County Community College (AACC)

All applicants must submit their online application HERE by 11:59 p.m. on March 15, 2025.

Year	Requirements
Year 1	 T4AA recipients must enroll and attend a degree-granting college or university in Maryland where education courses are offered, including AACC, and agree to participate in paid AACPS work experience throughout their college experience. T4AA recipients must apply as a temporary AACPS. T4AA recipients will initially receive a \$5,000 scholarship, paid directly to the student, to assist with college expenses. Within 30 days of the end of each semester, the T4AA recipient must sent an official copy of their transcript to the Executive Director of the Education Foundation of AACPS. A 2.5 minimum GPA is required with a. 2.8 GAP in related coursework. Following the T4AA recipient's first year of college, they must work in one of the many AACPS summer camp programs as a paid staff member for approximately 4-6 weeks. Year 2	



	 Upon successful completion of their first year of college and the summer camp work experience, T4AA recipients will receive an additional \$5,000 for their second year of college. The T4AA recipient is required to send an official copy of their transcript to the Executive Director of the Education Foundation of AAPCS. A 2.5 minimum GPA is required and a 2.8 GPA in required coursework. Following the T4AA recipient's second year of college, they must work in either one of the AACPS summer camp programs or in one of the AACPS summer school programs.
Year 3	 Upon successful completion of their second year of college and the summer work experience, T4AA recipients will the third installment of \$5,000 for their third year of college expenses. During the T4AA's recipient's third (junior) year of college, they are encouraged to apply for and accept substitute teaching positions during school breaks. The T4AA recipient is required to send an official copy of their transcript to the Executive Director of the Education Foundation of AAPCS. A 2.5 minimum GPA is required and a 2.8 GPA in required coursework. In the summer between the T4AA recipient's third and fourth (senior) year of college, they must serve as a paid Teaching Assistant in one of AACP's summer schools. During this experience, they will have the opportunity to co-teach classes. A copy of the satisfactory performance review from the position must be forwarded to the Executive Director of the Foundation.
Year 4	 To receive the fourth and final \$5,000 installment, T4AA recipients with a. GPA of 2.8 or higher must be offered an accept a teaching position with Anne Arundel County Public Schools. A signed contract of offer letter must be presented to the Executive Director of the Education Foundation of AACPS. If a T4AA recipient does not accept a teaching position with AACPS within one year of graduating college, then the final \$5,000 installment will be forfeited.
